

## **Know about Disability Certificate**

## Benefits in Karnataka

- To encourage enrolment and to continue the studies of the PWDs State Government provides scholarships to the students.
- Incentive Awards to Meritorious Students with disability: The scheme provides one-time Incentive Award to Meritorious disabled students who secure more than 60% of marks in public examinations.
- The Government has provided 3% reservation in A and B Post and 5% reservation in C and 'D' category of posts in all Government recruitments. The Government has also identified different kinds of jobs, which can be suitable for persons with disability.
- State Government extends 100% financial assistance to Bangalore based NGO called NAB to run a centre to impart vocational training in light engineering, plastic moulding, cane wiring etc. Visually impaired and hearing-impaired students who have completed SSLC can undergo this vocational training which helps them to find suitable job.
- The Government of Karnataka through the Directorate of Employment and Training has established Special Employment Exchange at Bangalore. The educated / literate disabled persons are at liberty to register their names seeking employment.
- With an objective of enriching the skills and empowering of the disabled in getting placement in private sector, the Dept. has started a scheme called "Training and Employment to disabled Persons"
- HOSTELS FOR DISABLED EMPLOYEES AND TRAINEES:
- The department runs 2 hostels for working of under trainee persons with disability separate hostel for women and men are functioning at Bangalore.
- SELF EMPLOYMENT PROGRAMME: Under this scheme financial assistance is given to eligible disabled
  persons to set up petty business. An amount of Rs.20,000 is given as interest free loan as working
  capital and a Kiosk worth of Rs.15,000 to setup business.
- Aids and Appliances: Must be resident of Karnataka for the last 10 years and should be certified by the Tahasildar. Annual Income limit is Rs.24000 for urban areas and Rs.11500 for rural areas inhabitants.
- Person with Disability who is economical conditions are poor and unable to maintain himself with
  food clothing and shelter and could not meet other basic needs is paid monthly maintenance
  allowance of Rs.400 per month. Around 4.00 lakhs persons with disabilities are available this benefit
  and Annual budgetary burden on the exchequer is around Rs.200 crores. Tahsildar of the taluk is the
  sanctioning authority. Rs.1000/- will be given for the persons who have more than 75% above
  disability. (Persons who have severe disability conditions)

How to Obtain Disability Certificate / UDID Card		
in Karnataka		

- First need to enrol online website http://www.swavlambancard.gov.in/pwd/application
- After receiving the enrolment number need to visit your nearest Government Hospital and submit the form with registration number.
- You can visit any of the hospitals listed in the next section for getting yourself assessed and apply for a disability certificate.
- An appointment will be fixed with the Neuro doctor of the said hospital. PWD has to personally meet the doctor for assessment.
- In case the person with disability cannot be personally present in the hospital, a parent/guardian can approach the medical board and discuss the case to see what other arrangement could be made for disability assessment.

## Documents required for Disability Certificate/UDID

Carry the following documents while going for assessment or for applying a disability certificate:

- 1. Enrolment number form.
- Two recent coloured passport size photos of the person with disability.
- Copy of the I.D. proof (Aadhar Card/ Voter ID/ Passport)
- 4. Copy of the address proof.
- 5. Copies of available medical reports.
- 6. Original Disability
  Certificate (In case
  availed earlier)

If possible, it is advisable to speak with the hospital you're planning to visit about what documents are required for the issuance of disability certificate.
